Dear Carl:

After checking station records, I am pleased to confirm your reception of WRVR-AM on March 11, 1986.

WRVR-AM is a unlimited time station operating non-directionally at 10,000 watts daytime and directionally at 5,000 watts night with the major lobe to the southeast.

WRVR-AM uses an Amphet-10 transmitter (a 100% solid state unit made by Nautel of Canada) and broadcasts in AM stereo using Motorola's C-Quam system.

WRVR-AM (sister to class C FM WRVR) was purchased in March of 1985 from Adams broadcast. In years goneby, it has operated under the call letters of WKDJ and WMPS.

I suspect that your original letter was a victim of the change of address we incurred when we relocated the AM studios after the purchase, however, I'm glad you were able to find us. Thank you for your report and happy DXing.
