Dear Sir:

I am writing to you in connection with my reception of your radio station on 1410 kilohertz which I heard back on December 30, 1976 from 5:20 p.m. to 5:24 p.m. Central Standard Time. I mailed a letter reporting my reception to your chief engineer shortly after the above logging, but as of yet have never received a reply. Several of my fellow National Radio Club members have told me that they have received replies from K B A N, so perhaps mine somehow went astray. The following is a summary of my reception.

- 5:20 A test of the Emergency Broadcast Facilities.
- 5:21 Station Identification-"You're listening to K B A N Radio, Bowie, Tex."
- j:22 Recorded Country-Western Music.
- 5:24 An announcement mentioning the local Chamber of Commerce.
- 5:24 Time check followed by personal announcements, and weather.

Your signals were a fair S-3 with considerable interference from several stations, none of which I was able to identify. My receiver is a Hammarlund HQ-180AC which has 18 tubes. My antenna is a 2' Directional Altazmuth Loop.

Please look over the details of this report. If you find it to be correct and to your satisfaction, I would appreciate receiving a brief letter or card stating that my reception of K B A N is verified. I have 1,902 verifications, including 158 from the Lone Star State. Yours would be a most welcome addition to my collection. I have enclosed return postage for your convenience in making a reply. Thanks for your time and interest.
