Dear Sir:

I am pleased to report to you my reception of your radio station on 1280 kilohertz this morning, February 9, 1983 at 12:09 a.m. Central Time. The following is a summary of my reception at that time:

12:09 Identification Announcement-"This is K E A N, Abilene, Texas".

12:10 A continuous tone of about 1 khz.

12:14 The tone disappeared.

I am sorry that this is not a more comprehensive report, but the interference was just too great. It was primarily W G S O in New Orleans. My receiver is a Kenwood R-1000 and my antenna is a 12" ferrite core altazmuth loop.

If you find this report to be correct and to your satisfaction, I would very much appreciate receiving a brief letter or card stating that my reception of K E A N is verified. I have 2,155 verifications, including 190 from the Lone Star State. Yours would be a most welcome addition to my collection. I have enclosed a stamp for your reply. Thank you very much for your time. I hope that this has been of interest to you.
