Dear Carl;

Thank you for the letter dated 26 May 1979. Yes we were running frequency tests on the morning of May 23. We have a frequency measuring service that checks our frequency monthly. We broadcast an 800 cycle tone for approximately 10 to 12 minutes starting shortly after midnite. KNAL is inserted in code.

We are a 500 watt fulltime station using a "country music" format. We stress news and sports. Our city is approximately 50,000 located about 40 miles inland from the Gulf of Mexico and about midway between Houston and Corpus Christi.

I assume from your signature that you are a "ham operator" also. My call letters are K5LGD. I have Advanced Amateur Class License but am not too active except during hurricane season. This is the hurricane season, June until September, so I am now in the process of checking my antennas and other associated equipment getting ready.
