Gentlemen:

I am pleased to report reception of your station on February 22, 1976 from 5:02 a.m. to 5:03 a.m. Central Standard Time on 910 kcs. Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

5:02 a.m. Sign On Announcement-"Good Morning. This is Radio Station W T O Y 910 kilohertz in Roanoke, Virginia. W T O Y Radio is owned and operated by T & H Broadcasting, Incorporated....licensed by the Federal Communications Commission. W T O Y Main Studios are located at 26 East Church Avenue in Roanoke, Virginia and our transmitter located at.....W T O Y operates with 1,000 watts at 910 kilohertz on the AM dial. Join us for our broadcast day."

I am sorry that I was unable to get a more detailed logging on your station, but the interference was just too great.
