This letter is to confirm your reception of CKUA's transmission on 93.7 Mhz on Friday July 17, 1987. The program Cultural Crossroads is broadcast Friday evenings between 7:30 - 8:30 mountain time. A program called Windspeaker follows at 8:30. Between programs we air station identification.

A note of interest CKUA's programming originates from studios in Edmonton, Alberta. The signal is transmitted via satellite to 15 FM transmitters throughout the province. The programming is also broadcast on the AM band at 580 Khz with a single transmitter located just south of Edmonton.

I hope this letter of confirmation is satisfactory. It's always enjoyable to get letters from people in other parts of the world who have heard our signal. We have had letters as far away as Sweden.

Again, thank you for the interest you've shown in our station and keep in touch.
