I received your letter and we appreciate you letting us know about our signal. We just increased our power to 100,000 watts in late May. We are at an elevation of about 1900 feet which is about 500 feet above average terrain.

I have enclosed a KIX-104 bumper sticker just in case you collect them. KKIX was originally KNWA, which signed on in 1966 or 67. Noalmark Broadcasting bought the station in 1983 and changed the call letters and format. The station has been rated number one by Arbitron since 1983.
