First let me apologize for the delay in your reply. We are in the process of moving two AM stations (WKHT 1230 Manchester and WNAQ 1380 Waterbury) to the FM facilities in Hartford. The two AM's are simulcasting country music.

We were amazed to receive a DX Report from Kansas, but obviously, you were in the right place at the right time. Your log was correct, and for your trouble, I am enclosing a copy of the log for June 13, 1987, between 7 and 8PM ET. Also, enclosed is a little information on WLVH-FM. WLVH is a 50,000 watt station with the transmitter located on top of Meriden Mountain. "The Mountain", home to many FM stations, relay stations and telephone relay stations. It is approximately 800 feet above sea level.
