This will verify your reception of WBBQ-AM June 8, 1972, 8:13 to 8:26 PM.

We were using a Gates BC-250-GY transmitter (almost 26 years old and still going strong) with 250 watts power, feeding a 200 foot uniform cross section vertical tower.

During the daytime we switch to a 1000 watt transmitter.

Your reception, undoubtedly caused by strage atmospheric conditions, is quite amazing, since most of the reports we receive are during the test period shortly after midnight Monday morning, once a month; when we use the 1000 watt transmitter for testing.
