Thank you for your reception report of FOX 97 on May 31, 1990. The details of your reception of our station were in complete agreement with our station logs. I should note, however, that the identification announcement at 7:37 CDT was "FOX 97, Atlanta's All Oldies Station". We are not Atlanta's oldest FM station. In fact, FOX 97 is actually licensed to Gainesville, GA, a small town located approximately 50 miles northeast of Atlanta.

For your information, WFOX operates with an effective radiated power of 97 kW at an elevation of 1570 feet above average terrain. The antenna center of radiation is 2586 feet above-mean-sea-level, and the transmitter site is located approximately 38 miles northeast of Atlanta. WFOX is owned and operated by Shamrock Broadcasting, Inc. You may recognize the Shamrock name as we also own KUDL and WHB in Kansas City.

We are always quite fascinated when we receive reports like yours due to sporatic-E conditions. Once again, thank you for your very accurate report.
