Thank you for your DX listening report of WJSP-FM in Warm Springs, Georgia on May 31, 1988.


I can confirm for you your reception of one of our network stations as the information you reported is accurate.

WJSP-FM (88.1 MHz) is a 100,000 watt station located on Pine Mountain near Columbus, Georgia. It was the first of six stations to go on the air 3½ years ago.

Sporadic E-skip does some strange things with RF signals. One thing you did not mention was the length of time you received this signal. I assume it lasted two or three minutes before fading out.

Thanks for letting us know, Carl. I've enclosed a copy of our current program guide though it won't be of much value; E-skip is fickle at best!
