

Dear Carl:

I am responding to your letter of some weeks back for confirmation of your D-Xing of our station. I am sorry that you did not hear from your first letter, but I hope this suffices.

I can, indeed, confirm the information you gave for our programming at that time. You were right when you said that conditions must have been just right on that day. We operate with 100 kw from a 900 foot tower about 3 miles east of Sioux City and 2 miles west of Lawton, Iowa. We have an excellent signal that comes very near Omaha and any reception beyond that is, indeed, unusual.
