
Dear Carl,

This is to verify your reception of KJCK-FM from 10:55a.m. to 11:06a.m. on June 26, 1967 at a frequency of 94.5 Mhz.

Our FM transmitter is a Gates Model 7.5FM-G feeding a 12 bay Gates cycloid antenna mounted on our 540 ft. CATV tower. Our ERP is 86,500 watts. The transmitter site is approximately one mile from Junction city and the transmitter is controlled by a Gates RDC-10C remote control system from our new studios at W. 6th at Garfield. The majority of the equipment at both KJCK-FM and KJCK is Gates.

Thanks very much for the report and we always welcome DX reports on KJCK found at 1420 Kilohertz.
