This is to verify your reception of KJCK-FM from 10:55a.m. to 11:06a.m. on June 26, 1967 at a frequency of 94.5 MHz.

Our FM transmitter is a Gates Model 7.5FM-G feeding a 12 bay Gates cycloid antenna mounted on our 540 ft. CATV tower. Our ERP is 86,500 watts. The transmitter site is approximately one mile from Junction city and the transmitter is controlled by a Gates RDC-10C remote control system from our new studioes at W. 6th at Garfield.
