I am pleased to verify your reception report of WSRS dated 6/14/87. WSRS is a 20kW FM station with studios and transmitter facilities located in Paxton, Ma, atop Mt. Asnebumskit, at the outer edge of the city of Worcester. Our present site is very near the site of an experimental FM station which was operated around 1940 by Maj. Edwin Armstrong, who is considered by many to be the father of FM broadcasting.

WSRS's format consists of light adult contemporary music. We recently completed vast studio expansions and use much of the latest broadcasting equipment in our production and on-air studios.
