Thank you for your reception report.

KWPM-FM operates with a power of 77.2KW H and 77.2 KW V and was one of the first FM stations in Missouri to use dual polarization. Our present antenna height is only 390 feet above average terrain. We hope to be increasing power to a full 100 KW with true circular polarization and increase antenna height some two hundred to three hundred feet in the near future, pending F. C. C. approval.

A friend of mine used to visit in the Kansas City area quite frequently and would punch our FM up on his car stereo just southeast of Kansas City and listen to us all the way to West Plains -- usually with only minimal problems. I, myself, have listened to Cardinal baseball on KWPM-FM while visiting family in Concordia, Missouri.

Again, thank you for your report, and if you're ever in our neck of the woods, I'd be happy to give you our nickel tour!
