Dear Mr. Dabelstein:

Please consider this letter, verification of your reception of KAWL-FM, the morning of July 14, 1971.

Your description of programming was accurate except for the time which appeared to be two to three minutes fast.

KAWL-FM is operating separate from KAWL-AM at the present time. The FM studios and transmitter site are located one mile South of York. E.R.P. is 2,750 Watts from a three bay circularly polarized antenna which is centered at 310 feet above average terrain.

At your time of reception our frequency was 104,900,200 cycles with nine and a half per cent of ourmodulation being used for a stereo pilot carrier which was measured at 19,000.07 cycles.

You may be interested in knowing that we had a  ${\tt DK}$  from Omaha just the other day. Although he termed it freak, he had us strong on rabbit ears.
