This confirms your reception of KOMJ 103.7 FM on March 5, 1990,
at 12:48pm. Your reception comes just one week before a call sign change.

KOMJ signed on from a new 1200' tower 5 miles west of Hancock, Iowa,
in March 1988. Prior to that the station was KJAN-FM, Atlantic, Iowa.
The station is still licensed to Atlantic, with studios in Omaha and
a dual city legal ID. The transmitter site, midway between Omaha and
Atlantic, puts a 3.16 signal over both markets. Enclosed is a coverage
map.

Please write again after our new call letters are introduced. Along
with new calls we'll have a new letterhead. It's an extreme measure
to get away from this terrible purple stationery, but necessary.
