KWHG-fm is pleased to acknowledge your report of reception of our station on 6 July 1965. Comparison of your logging with ours shows that it was indeed KWHG-fm to which you were listening, although our correct address is 443 South 13th street, rather than 443 South 15th street as you reported.

KWHG-fm officially signed on on 3 May 1965, after some test period. Antenna used is a four-bay Jampro, with a gain of 4.1. Our effective radiated power is 3000 watts, which is the maximum for class A fm radio stations; licensed transmitter power is 787 watts. KWHG-fm has now pending before the FCC an application for 25,000 watts on a class C channel so that we may better serve the Omaha area.

We thank you for your report--such information is used in contour plotting.
