Thank you for the reception report of July 1, 1972

WREO AM at 970 Khz. operates at 5,000 watts days and 1,000 watts nights. The station is located three miles south of Ashtabula and has been on the air since September 21, 1937. We are directional day and night with a four tower array and a Collins 820-E1 5 kw. transmitter and an RCA BTA-1R1 1 kw. transmitter.

WREO FM Stereo at 97.1 Mhz. operates with an effective, radiated power of 53,000 watts day and night. WREO FM has been on the air since 1949. The transmitter is made by General Electronics Laboratories and the automatic play-back units were manufactured by Continental.

The AM and FM coverage is from west of Cleveland to east of Erie, Pennsylvania, to the south below Youngstown, Ohio, and to the north into Canada.

WREO carries all the Cleveland Indians baseball games and Cleveland Browns football games.
