We sincerely appreciate receiving your report of reception of WMT-TV, Channel 2.

We operate with 100,000 watts power, the maximum permitted on VHF channels 2 through 6. The first program on WMT-TV was transmitted on September 30, 1953. At the time we began with 100,000 watts power and were the first television station in the United States beginning with the 100,000 watts power.

The transmitting antenna is 1,450 feet above the surrounding terrain and is located 23 miles northwest of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, near Urbana, Iowa.

WMT-TV transmits CBS network programs and is fully color equipped. Our hours of operation are:

Weekdays 7:00 am to 12:30 midnight Sundays 7:30 am to 12:30 midnight.

Your report of the reception of WMT-TV is certainly appreciated. We do wish to extend our invitation to you to visit us when you are in or near our area.
