
Dear Mr. Dabelstein:

Thank you for your letter of June 25, 1961 reporting reception from this station. As we do not send out any "QSL" cards, this letter will serve to acknowledge your report of reception.

As you probably know, atmospheric conditions and sun spots exert quite an influence on reception. Sun spots generally occur during the summer. Their intensity varies in cycles, and therefore, some years are much worse than others. During these periods, the pattern of radio and television reception is greatly changed. We, therefore, have an audience hundreds of miles distant at times when people in our normal primary reception area are having difficulty for a short period of time.

We appreciate your interest in our programs, and hope you will continue to watch them whenever possible.
