Thank you for your letter reporting the reception of KATU, Channel 2, Portland, Oregon. We appreciate your interest in our signals and in reporting these unusual long-distance transmissions from our station.

Such long-rang transmissions are an unusual occurrence caused by a propagation phenomenon of sporadic tropospheric effects where the signal is reflected or refracted in an unusual manner by ionized layers in the earth's atmosphere producing a "skip" effect on the signals.

KATU operates with 100 kilowatts of effective radiated power from an antenna located at an 1,838-ft. elevation on Skyline Ridge near Portland.
