This will confirm your reception report of our station KUSD-TV, Channel 2, Vermillion on September 16, 1972 from 9:59 to 10:05 a. m. CDT. Your description of our identification slide was correct.

KUSD-TV operates from a transmitter located two miles south of Beresford, South Dakota (Union County) with an authorized visual power of 100,000 watts and an aural power of 20,000 watts. The antenna is a bat-wing type 657 feet above ground (2,167 feet above sea level).
