Thank you very much for your recent signal report. Thanks also for the complimentary remarks about the reception of our signal.

We are in the Mountain Standard Time Zone. Our power output is 250 watts, 19 hours daily, at 1190 KC. Our Collins 300J 250-100 Watt AM Broadcast Transmitter feeds a two tower directional array, which radiate our RF northeast and southwest.

Our format is 100% Spanish programming, and our operating schedule runs from 4:59 AM to 12 Midnight, MST.

I enclose one of our coverage maps, which I hope will be of interest to you. Thanks much again for writing, and we hope you'll be able to receive us again sometime.
