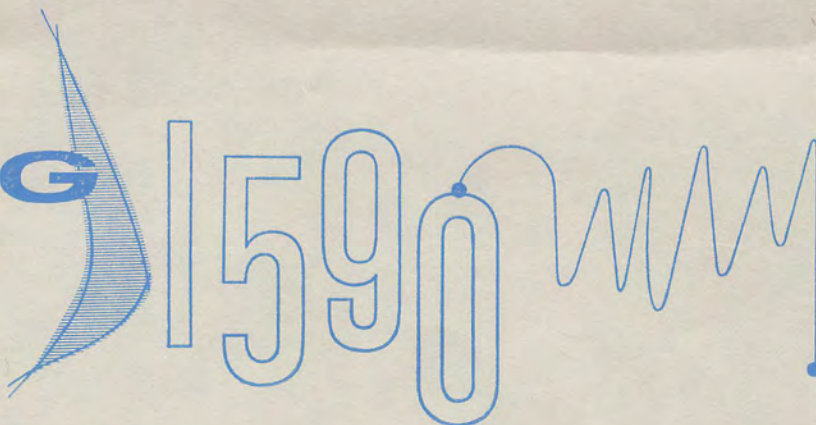

This note will confirm your signal report of 12/2/62. WYNG was indeed on the air at the time, broadcasting a test program to check our night signal contours. While WYNG is presently limited to daytime broadcasting we are planning to file for unlimited hours. Your report will help us out in preparing the application.

Technically, WYNG looks like this.

Transmitter: Gates - 1000watts Model BC-1E  
Antenna: 1/4 wave 183' steel tower  
Ground: Salt water radials  
Location: On Greenwich Bay in Warwick, R.I.
