Dear Mr Dangerfield:

From your description I would say that the station you picked up was in fact CFSE radio from RCAF Station Senneterre, Quebec, Canada.

CFSE is owned and operated by the personnel of this RCAF station. We are licensed to broadcast on 1450 kcs. However, we do not have the equipment required to accurately measure our frequency as it is quite reasonable that you picked us up at 1427 kcs. Our peak power output is 50 watts. We broadcast from 6:00 pm to midnight Monday to Friday; from 12 noon to midnight on Saturday and from 12 noon to 6:00 pm Sunday.

With the exception of the station director and the manager, our staff is composed entirely of volunteer airmen and airwomen, working as broadcast and maintenance staff.

CFSE was set up primarily to entertain English speaking servicemen and their dependents in a French speaking part of the country. However, some of our broadcasts are made in French.

I am sure that your hobby is interesting. If there is any further information which we can supply, please do not hesitate to ask, as we will be happy to help if possible.
