Sorry for the delay in replying. Thank you for your letter of the 8th of April, 1964.

I am extremely pleased to confirm that the signals you mentioned did indeed originate from this station, and this frequency 885 kcs. We settled on this frequency as opposed to 845 because a neighbouring Island had recently opened up on a frequency very close to this.

1550 was becoming rather cluttered up and we decided that 885 was fairly clear, and that we should switch to it.

We are radiating from a 200 foot vertical mast, and as far as possible, extending our hours of broadcasting; we are most grateful to you for your letters & reports and I will make it my business to keep in touch with you, regarding any future alterations and extensions of our service.
