
Dear Mr. Dangerfield:

Thank you for your letter, in which you outlined your reception of our broadcast on the morning of Friday, November 24, 1961.

Your report coincides with our station's log. At the time of your reception we were testing our new 5 kw transmitter at various times between the hours of 1:00 and 4:00 A.M. (Atlantic Standard Time).

We have only recently been authorized to increase our power from .25 kw to 5 kw, and we will continue testing our new 5 kw transmitter until we feel that we are in shape to pass final inspection by the Federal Communications Commission District Engineer.
