We have been extremely interested in receiving your letter of March 14 1961, including your listening report of our new Broadcasting Station RADIO-CARIBBEAN?

RADIO CARIBBEAN is quite a new station, since we are on the air only for three weeks. We operate on 840 kcs. with a power of 11,000 watts. Our transmitter is a COLLINS 2I-M. with an aerial (insulated, guyed tower) of 145 feet high, located on the north coast of St.Lucia, Windward Islands.

We broadcast every day from 4.00 p.m. GMT until 2.00 a.m. GMT : Music, news and avertisements both in english and in french.

Your report is excellent, and follows exactly our program. Our technicians are very proud to know that our Station has been heard as far as Pennsylvania !

Pretty soon we are intending to change our frequency and to operate on 830 kcs. in order to avoid interferences with Radio-Bogota(840kcs). A new report of your listening on that frequency would be welcomed , and we thank you very much if you can do !
