
Dear Sir,

Thank you for your interesting letter of November 23rd. We are very pleased to be able to confirm the correctness of your reception report and can verify that 1151 kilocycles (260.6 metres) is currently used by two of the BBC North of England Home Service transmitters Scarborough and Stagshaw - the latter being the high-power transmitter which serves the northern parts of England.

The programme content you mention is perfectly correct and does line up with our programmes as broadcast.

We have much pleasure in sending you one of our acknowledgement cards together with our programme schedule listing shortwave frequencies. Transmission on Medium Waves is heard frequently in the United States although admittedly it is rather rare during the mid Winter period as it is usually confined to the Equinox period.
