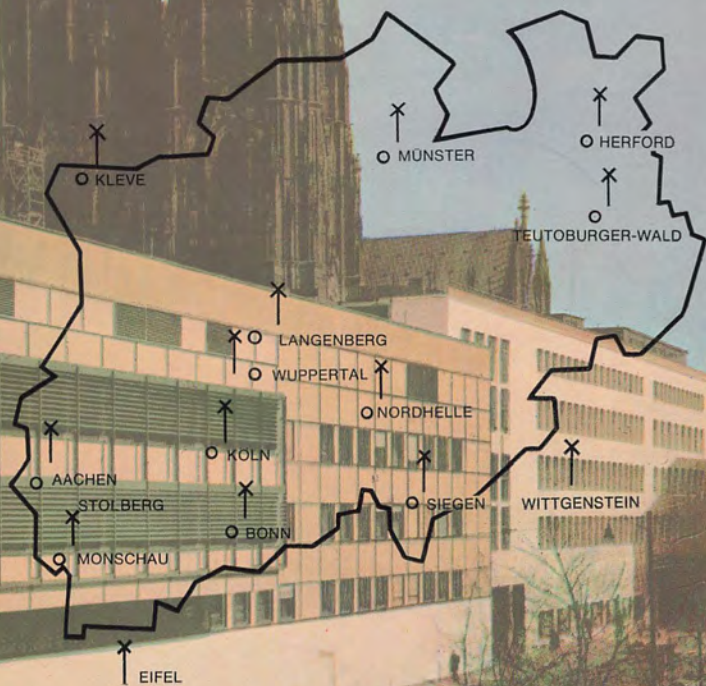



Dear Mister Dangerfield!

Thank you very much for your reception report, which is very useful for us.

On the frequency 1586 kHz (189 m) the WESTDEUTSCHER RUNDFUNK has started on 24<sup>th</sup> of July 1966 in Langenberg a new medium-wave-transmitter. This frequency was used till July 24<sup>th</sup> by some small stations of the two german radio organisations "Westdeutscher Rundfunk, Köln" (WDR) and "Norddeutscher Rundfunk, Hamburg" (NDR). Now it is used only by Langenberg. The present power is 400 kW; in summer 1967 it will have 800 kW.

Our station Langenberg is located between Dortmund and Düsseldorf. It is transmitting the common first Radioprogramme of the WDR and NDR; therefore you can either hear the announcement: "Hier ist der Westdeutsche Rundfunk, Erstes Programm" or "Hier ist der Norddeutsche Rundfunk, Erstes Programm".
