
Dear Mr. Dangerfield:

I've received and answered your DX, reception report to this WA. As we have not QSL cards I have made one for you.

With this am turning ^{back} one of you, your international Reply Coupons. As also am a DXer, I see is very expensive for you send one or two coupons with each DX, so if you wish I can send mexican stamps, for a single letter or card via ordinary is 30 centavos, mexican currency, this in american money is 4 cents. Same thing but air mail is 50 centavos, equivalent to 7 cents, so if you wish we can exchange stamps. So your DX's will be as expensive as 7 cents air mail or 4 cents ordinary. All you need is tell me.
