Dear Mr. Dangerfield;

In response to your kind letter, received through Mr. Halpine, Information Officer of the American Embassy in my country, I wish to congratulate you for your remarkable good reception of Radio Nanduti on the medium meter wave so far away.

Now, to confirm your "Reception Report" in detail, your log reports on Monday Feb. 25 are in absolute conformity with ours. Concerning your log report on Radio Nanduti of Monday Feb. 4 it is also correct. The program you heard was probably "Buenas días Américas, buenas días Brasil" which was a special program we did on Brazil at that time.

The News Broadcast at 5:30 am. also confirms with our schedule. I should only like to add that we abandoned our summertime schedule which initiated our daily programs at 5 am. on May 14, changing it to 6 am. We expect to start our earlier schedule again on October 1 this year.

Hoping that you will be able to tune us in again, and that this letter will suffice to include us in your reception report list as 75th country received by you on the medium meter wave band, I wish you "good reception of many more countries."
