Thank you very much for your interesting and informative letter of February 27th. This is our verification of your reception of this station on that date.

You can well imagine how well pleased we are that you heard us with such clarity at that distance.

Last December KFAR increased its power from 5,000 to 10,000 watts, and changed frequency from 610 to 660 kilocycles.

As you probably know, 660 is a clear channel assignment, which should allow reception in the East when WEAF has signed off the air. If you ever hear us again, we'd surely appreciate another reception report.
