Dear Mr. Geary:

In answer to your letter of October 26th we are glad to assure you that our log of October 25th checks in every detail with yours, including the scheduling of the Penetro transcription at 7:00 o'clock, before "Cavalcade of America".

WALA operates on a frequency of 1410 kilocycles between the hours of 6 AM and 11 PM Central War Time, with a power of 5000 watts. Our transmitter station is located on Cochrane Bridge Causeway in approximately the center of Mobile Bay. Our towers are 225 feet above sea level - our equipment the latest model RCA 5 DX transmitter.

We're always happy to answer requests like yours for verification. Good luck and good reception.
