Many thanks for your letter reporting reception of WGDA on October 26, 1947 at 7:00 AM.

Your report is quite correct and we appreciate the information on our signal and modulation.

WGDA operates on 620 kc with 1600 watts from sunrise until local sunset. The Georgia Alabama Broadcasting Corp. also operates WGDA-FM fulltime on 95.1 mc with 9000 watts.

You might be interested in knowing that WSAC, Columbus, Ga. is going on the air with equipment tests soon on 1460 kc. with 1000 watts.
