We were very happy to receive your letter, reporting having heard WHOS, while on equipment test.

From the information you gave, there seems to be no doubt that you were listening to WHOS. We appreciate your report and the information you gave us, will be invaluable in calculating our signal.

I will give you an idea of the equipment we use here, the transmitter is Western Electric 443, 1000 watts. We operate daytime only, as you know the 443 has the doherty high efficiency final. We are using Western Electric equipment throughout, with the exception of a few Shure microphones.

The location of Decatur, is approximately midway between Nashville, Tennessee and Birmingham, Alabama.
