In reply to your letter some time ago I am happy to confirm your receiption of this station at the time logged by you. The broadcast logged by you was our regular frequency measurement schedule.

I am sorry that I have delayed so long in answering your letter but we are very busy at this time prepairing for the construction of new transmitter and studio facilities. That is the reason for the change of call letters that you will notice on this letterhead. We hope to go on 850 kcs with 5000 Watts (daytime) and 1000 Watts (directional to the Southwest nighttime) in July.

Our regular frequency measurement schedule is the 2nd Sunday of each month from 12:20 to 12:35 AM CST. I pass this information along so that if any of your friends should like to try to catch us they might try at that time. I promise to answer the letters even though the naswers may be delayed by construction conditions here at the station at the time the letters are received.
