THIS IS TO CONFIRM YOUR RECEPTION OF RADIO STATION WZZK-AM ON
27 NOVEMBER 1986 DURING THE TIME PERIOD 4:36pm CST - 4:45pm CST.

WZZK OPERATES AT 610kHz WITH A DAYTIME NON-DIRECTIONAL POWER OUTPUT OF 5,000 WATTS AND A NIGHTTIME DIRECTIONAL PATTERN AT 1,000 WATTS. OUR TRANSMITTER SITE IS LOCATED AT THE ALABAMA STATE FAIR GROUNDS JUST WEST OF BIRMINGHAM WITH STUDIOS IN THE TOWERS BUILDING ATOP RED MOUNTAIN. OUR MAIN TRANSMITTER IS A COLLINS POWER ROCK 823-A WITH AN OLD RCA AMPLI-PHASE IN HOT STANDBY MODE. BEFORE OUR PURCHASE OF THE FACILITY TWO YEARS AGO THE STATION WAS KNOWN AS WSGN. WZZK ALSO OPERATES WZZK-FM-- A ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND WATT FACILITY WITH ANTENNA BAYS LOCATED ON A 13 HUNDRED FOOT TOWER ALSO LOCATED ON RED MOUNTAIN. THAT FACILITY USES TWO CONTINENTAL 25 KILO-WATT TRANSMITTERS IN A COMBINED CONFIGURATION.
