Dear Mr. Geary:

This will verify your DX report of November 10 for our frequency check of November 9, 1939 as correct.

I would like to thank you for this report and I might say that it is one of the most complete reports received by me since being connected with KCRJ. My best wishes for you future DXing.

We have a composite transmitter here and are operating with a power of two hundred fifty watts since the third of October at which time we were granted an increase in nighttime power. We have a vertical antenna which is one hundred fifty feet in height. We have moved into our own building and have generally increased the general appearance of the station as a whole. If you should ever be in this part of the country please accept this as a personal invitation to drop in and pay us a visit.

May I again thank you for the report and wish you 73's and the best of luck in your future dxing.
