Your very fine letter of 28 January received and noted with pleasure, this date. We, here at WIND, appreciate the interest shown in us by you, and other members of the National Radio Club.

The reception report of 27 and 28 Jan., is verified by our daily operational log, and we are very pleased with the fine reception you enjoyed.

Nouasseur is located 20 miles inland of Casablanca, French Morocco. Our transmitter is located in a valley between two large hills.

We use a government T-4 transmitter, and a 250 foot broadcast antenna.


The comparison to the AFN stations (2 of which operate with 350 kw power) was particularly gratifying.

It may be of interest to you that we have received reception reports also from Sweden, Germany, Spain, Portugal, and Gibraltar.

Thank you, again, for your letter, and let us hear from you at anytime you hear us, please.
