It is a pleasure to acknowledge your reception report of January 9th and I take this opportunity to express our sincere appreciation for your interest in kIQs ("kicks"), Willows, California.

For your information, kIQs operates with a power of 250 watts from sunrise to sunset. Transmitter: RCA, 250 watts. Antenna: nondirectional, vertical, 145 feet high. Ground System: 120 radials, 160 feet long. Ground Conductivity: Very high in this area. We are located in the Valley of the Sacramento River and the surrounding terrane is extremely flat in all directions for at least 20 miles. We went on the air officially, December 29, 1961.

Again, thank you very much for your encouraging report and for taking the time to write to kiQs.
