This confirms your reception report of 7-10-48.

A check of our log against your report shows substantial agreement, and I have every reason to believe ours was the station you heard.

Equipment here includes an RCA BTA-1L 1KW transmitter and a two-tower directional array pulled down in the direction of KSTP, St. Paul, which is 61 degrees true from San Jose.

We operate 24 hours daily with the exception of Monday mornings from 12:00 midnight to 6:00 a.m., when we shut down for necessary maintenance.
