Dear Sir,

We are glad to confirm you that the transmitter you have caught on January 17, 1954 on 1295 kcs. in the medium-wave band really was our station Osterloog. We were extraordinary interested in getting knowledge about your very good reception of our station. Several of your countrymen in the States reported reception in November and December 1953 and January 1954, too, but nobody told us about such an excellent and without any interference reception like yours. You are to be congratulated on your excellent receiver, though we are sure that such good reception is to attain only on occasion during especially easy terms of extension.

Our station has a power of 110 kW, our antenna is not directional and consists of a self-radiating tubular mast which is 132 m high and has a diameter of 0,9 m. We hope you will hear us more in the next time on the medium-wave band.

If you are interested in receiving our short wave transmitters we would appreciate it if you would control it. We broadcast in wintertime to North America from 01.30 - 05.30 A.M. GMT on 5980 and 7290 kHz. If you have caught it we would like to know in which volume and in which quality you have heard.
