Thanks for your letter of December 20th, 1952. As far as we can see here, your reception report was correct.

However, the direction of the program-section of Swedish broadcasting is centralized to Stockholm, capital of Sweden. The radio stations themselves, on the other hand, belong to the radio section of the board of Swedish telegraphs. Therefore all questions on the program service are to be sent to the Swedish broadcasting in Stockholm.

Consequently we have now forwarded your letter to Stockholm. We hope that you will receive the verification card you asked for, forwarded to you direct from the Swedish broadcasting.

We recommend that in the future, if you send reception reports of Swedish broadcasting stations, you will send them to the Swedish broadcasting; the address of it is:

The international reply coupon enclosed in your letter was not used by us here at the transmitting station; we enclosed it in the letter again when forwarding it to the Swedish broadcasting.
