we were immensely pleased to receive your reception report, the second one we ever got from the States and the first from Pennsylvania. In any case we have verified it and can affirm that you have listened indeed to Radio-Zagreb on Wednesday, November 11, 1953 from 4.17 to 5.00 h GMT.

From 4.17 to 4.20 you heard the news by a male announcer, and a light music programme followed. At five-minute intervals the announcer gave the time.

It is an astonishing fact indeed that you were able to listen to our programmes so far away, and we hope that you will have some more receptions of Radio-Zagreb.

The transmitter of Radio-Zagreb has 135 Kw, and the aerial is vertical, 120 meters high with top capacity.

We are wishing you many good receptions of other European stations.
