Thank you for your letter of November 28. Occasionally we do get reception reports from up your way, but they are very rare.

Yes, you were picking up our signal--and apparently loud and clear for part of the time. We are happy to confirm this.

Enclosed is our December program log, which we trust will be of interest to you. Also enclosed is a little leaflet that could just turn out to be the most important thing that you will ever read.

As you are aware, we do have FCC permission to go full time on 1520 kHz. We may not go through with this, however, because of the rather limited coverage. What you were hearing, however, was our 1000-watt, non-directional signal. Prior to a few months ago, we were directional, east and west with 1000 watts, and our signal was limited sharply north and south.

Have a meaningful Christmas, and if you don't know Him, may you come to know the Christ of Christmas.
