This letter is to confirm that you have heard our test broadcast of February 18, 1990 between the hours of 0400 and 0430 EST. Your valuable information helps me continue the learning process that is always ongoing in this art.

WLUS operates as a "daytime" station with 5,000 watts and uses a post-sunset authority power granted by the Federal Communications Commission of 166 watts until 2200 EST. Our transmitter is a MW-5A Harris and the antenna is a folded unipole, 242 feet tall. Our format is Big Band and is non-automated (live people making occasional mistakes and having fun).

My special thanks to Dan Andrews, Hans Borger and James Brown (owner) of WLUS that invested their time and hard work to help me complete this test broadcast.
