

This letter will serve as the verification of reception report for the test program broadcast by WEKS, Marietta, Georgia, on March 16, 1987 from 1:05am to 1:35am.

WEKS is a class two 10,000 watt daytime only radio station which operates on a U.S. clear channel at 1080 kHz. It broadcasts a directional signal pattern southeast toward the city of Atlanta from a three tower antenna array located on a 10 acre site in Marietta, Georgia. The transmitter is a 1965 RCA BTA-10U AM broadcast transmitter.

WEKS' sister station is WEKS-FM which broadcasts on 104.1 mHz with 60,000 watts ERP from a tower height 1,200 feet above average terrain.
